

The Pavilion Accessibility Information

Getting to The Pavilion

1. The Pavilion is located on the North side of the Recreation Ground in Balcombe, marked on the map as 'Balcombe FC'.



2. There is no specific parking for the Pavilion or the recreation ground although parking is available on nearby residential streets.



- 3. Step free access from Stockcroft Road is along a tarmacked access road (which has bollards to prevent cars entering) which passes the Parish Rooms on the right, followed by the Bowling Club. The access road leads to the entrance of the Recreation Ground, adjacent to the Pavilion and continues as paths in 2 directions around the edge of the recreation ground.
- 4. The access road from Stockcroft Road is shown in the following photos:





- 5. Access to the Recreation Ground is also available by paths leading from:
 - a. The top of Bramble Mead
 - b. The bottom of Bramble Hill (this is a steep access path)
 - c. Jobes (next to Watermead)
- 6. All of these have tarmacked access to the Pavilion around the edge of the Recreation Ground.

- 7. Access to the Pavilion is available through 2 doors to the front of the building:
 - 1) Step free and wheelchair access into the toilet lobby, with access onto the main room
 - 2) A single step into the main room
- 8. The building is all on one level.
